

## **Students Satisfaction Survey analysis**

**Academic Year 2019-20**

**Sample size of the survey:** -The College has made SSS available Online on the Institutional Website. Total 107 students submitted Online responses to the SSS. 15% students participated in the Online SSS.

**Sample selection method :** The students were informed about the availability of SSS questionnaire being made available on the Website and it was open for all survey.

**Survey Mode:** This survey was done through Online mode.

### **The Survey analysis report**

The 87.68% of students answered that 85 to 100% syllabus was covered in the class by the subject teachers.

89.13% students answered that the teachers were thoroughly prepared for their lecture.

93.84% students agreed that the teachers were able to communicate their subject content to the teachers effectively.

89.13% students agreed that the teachers approach to teaching as Excellent.

94.13% students agreed that teachers were always fair in the internal evaluation.

96.38% students agreed that the teachers discussed their performance in assignments every time.

96.74% students answered that the institute has regularly taken active interest in promoting internships, student exchange field visit opportunities for students.

92.75% students answered that the teaching and mentoring process in the institution has significantly facilitates them in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

92.75% students strongly agreed that the institution provided multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

95.65% students agreed that the teachers informed them every time about their expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes.

96.01% students agreed that the mentors every time did a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to them.

96.74% students agreed that every time the teachers illustrated the concepts through examples and applications.

96.01% students fully agreed that the teachers identified their strengths and encouraged them with providing the right level of challenges.

95.29% students agreed that the teachers every time identified their weaknesses and helped them to overcome them.

95.65% students strongly agreed that the institute made effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching-learning process.

96.38% students agreed that the institute/teachers used student-centric methods such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem-solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.

94.57% students strongly agreed that the teachers encouraged them to participate in extracurricular activities.

96.74% students agreed to a great extend that the institute/teachers made efforts to inculcate soft-skills, life skills, and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

89.74% students agreed that the teachers used ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia etc. while teaching.

93.12% students strongly agreed that the overall quality of the teaching-learning process in the institute is very good.

### **Action Taken Report**

The student satisfaction Survey analysis report was presented in the I.Q.A.C meeting for the discussion. The student responses question wise and teacher wise were discussed. It was agreed that though the maximum number of students have shown satisfaction about the teaching-learning quality, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities and overall college facilities still there is lot for improvement. The area that was to be focused for improvement as far as the teaching-learning process is concerned is the use of ICT tools. A few teachers have started use of Google classroom therefore it was decided to encourage teachers to use LMS like Google classroom to make teaching-learning process more student-centric. The I.Q.A.C. also informed the teachers about the gray areas where they need to improve as per the analysis of SSS. The institute has also applied for Google suit so as to make best use of the tools available. It was decided that the teachers will try and create E-content in form of PPT, You Tube content creation. The teachers were informed about the University E-content portal where they can submit their E-content material.
