

Performance of the institution in area distinctive to its vision, priority and thrust

The college has a stated goal to develop research aptitude and environmental awareness among students and teachers for social welfare. The College tried to conduct activities contributing to achieve this goal. The college in collaboration with Indian Institute of Tropical Meteorology and S.P.P.University, Pune participated in SAFAR Pollution Emission Survey of Pune District. Twenty-two volunteer students worked in this ten days long survey counting of pollution sources in Shirur taluka. The I.I.T.M. Pune uses this data for preparing their reports.

The College received Rs. 50000/- under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, M.H.R.D. In the academic year 2019-20, the College completed the survey of five villages focused on the implementation of government schemes at the ground level. The data was collected by the student volunteers under the guidance of the teachers and the same was submitted on the Unnat Bharat Portal. The college proposes to implement many such schemes contributing to the nation building. This types of survey also fulfills the institutional goal to inculcate research aptitude among students.

The College organized Entrepreneur development Program to inculcate professional skills among students. Mrs. Vasanti Mulajkar (VM3Tech Pvt ltd. Pune) and Mr. Somnath Bhujbal (Plastech Pvt. Ltd. Talegaon Dhamdhere) shared their experiences, ideas and strategies to develop entrepreneurship skills of students. This goes in accordance with the objective of the college to inculcate skills of students in the vicinity.

The girl students were given admission to EARN & LEARN scheme so as keeping with the objective laid by the institute to support female students in their pursuit of higher education. The Kranitijyoti Savitribai Phule Scholarshp' for 10 meritorious students was given.

The Commerce dept. organized group discussion based on the themes related to Costing subject.

The S.Y.B.Com. & B.A. students undertook environment research projects related to the local issues of environment.

The department of Geography organized poster presentation to create awareness about environment on the occasion of 'Geography Day'.

The teachers of the institute published 15 research papers in reputed journals. One of our faculties Mr. Vivek Khabde received Doctoral Degree this year. The college ensures that all necessary facilities are provided to teachers and students to undertake and conduct research in respective subjects.
